Participants must reserve space for displays and/or exhibits by May 1. This event will be advertised across multiple media platforms. This is a fundraiser to assist in the restoration of the WWII B-17G Lacey Lady. This is a family event designed to educate and inspire our community.

Each 10'x10' Vendor/Exhibitor space is \$75. The Vendor/Exhibitor is responsible to provide their own tent, tables and chairs. Tents must be 60 mph wind resistant. Vendors must carry B-17 Alliance as additionally insured. B-17 Alliance is a 501(c)3 non-profit and reserves the right to limit vendor registration.

B-17 Alliance is restoring one of America's most remarkable WWII aircraft, the former iconic "Bomber Gas Station" landmark from Milwaukie, Oregon. The B-17G Flying Fortress won the European Theater during WWII and united a proud nation. Let us never forget the sacrifice of a nation on an international and multicultural scale.
